The Logistics:

- A bus departures:
 1. Clare Gleeson St Car Park at 8:15 am pickups
 2. Auburn CWA 8:45,
 3. Tarlee Town Hall 9:10,
 4. Roseworthy Hotel 9:40 am
 5. Arrive at The Entertainment Centre Car Park approx 10:20 am with a walk to the Grain Lab to arrive 10:30 am.
- For those not on the bus, cars can park all day at Entertainment Centre and meet us via a short walk at The Grain Lab to commence tour at 11 am and hop on the bus to Outer Harbour after the laboratory tour.
- If you do not wish to stay for the Forum and/or Dinner) best to drive your car to Outer Harbour after the Grain Lab tour and park in the Royal SA Yacht Squadron car park where you will be picked up by the bus for the Outer Harbour tour.
- If you can't make the Lab tour meet us at 12 – 12:30 at the Yacht Squadron car park and hop on the bus for the Outer Harbour tours.
- Bus/s will depart following the dinner at 8pm and return to Clare via the Entertainment Centre.
